Other remarks	Other remarks			The warehouse facility was previously used as a food storage facility with a fairly large "cool zone" climat controlled section, broken down into four separate vestibules. Each vestibule can be calibrated to run o a different temperature range, and have thermal resistant door coverings. There is also a large climat controlled loading section, with space for palletization and four loading based. The climate controlle section (storage and loading section) makes up about 1/4 of the total usable floor space, has low ceilings and the racks were configured for hand loading, not forks. This will limit the amount of MHE and vertical racking that can be used in the space. The beams in the "cool zone" will need to be reconfigured to meet storage needs, and probably won't go higher than two pallets. There are three separate offices, including one extremely large office space in the middle. There are multiple freestanding rooms, a kitchen, and even a large conference space on the top floor. DSV opene up an office space for up to 15 WFP employees. The existing MHE is not in good shape, but DSV can import new items within a day or two. The office with have full electricity and internet. Building access is controlled through a security guard, and then door open through keyfobs. There is also safe permanent parking spots for seven 40 tonne trucks outside. The warehouse floor is in usable conditions. There are an estimated 6,000 full pallet positions in the mai section of the warehouse (non "cool zone"), fully functional overhead sprinkler system, crash barriers, fir lanes, marked spots on the floor for rows. Some of the racks are showing signs of distress and may nee to be repaired by SDV. Warehouse is not pharma rated, and is not bonded. The current climate controlled facility would be perfect for pharma, but would require authorization from Polish authorities. The site would also be perfect for bonded storage – clearly separated chambers with access control, but no bond has been issued of extended by SDV. Different "coo
